In this time of budget cuts, reduced funding, increased government oversight, and agency closings or bankruptcies, even the most needed and beneficial HIV/AIDS programs are at the mercy of a balanced budget. My sincerest and heartfelt congratulations for an incredible job well done also go out to the BP staff members who made this new edition a reality, especially Ray Smith, Carlos Molina, and Shakisha Wilson. How to Use this Resource Directory

Welcome to the 2005-2006 **Body Positive Resource Directory**. This is the first new edition of the directory to be published since 2001, and it has changed a great deal since that time. More than 150 new programs and services have been added, while some defunct programs have been deleted.

The *Resource Directory* seeks to cover HIV/AIDS service providers in the five boroughs of New York City as well as the as adjacent areas of Long Island and the northern suburbs (i.e., area codes 212, 718, 646, 343, 516 and 914.) While more than 250 services are included, we realize that there are others that we may have missed, and also that programs change over time. So if you spot anything missing or anything incorrect, please be sure to use the correction form on page 2 of the directory to help us update our listings.

We encourage you to think of this *Resource Directory* as a starting point in your search for programs and services. Don't get discouraged if you don't find exactly what you are seeking right away; remember that many agencies can provide you with referrals to other agencies. This would include the **Body Positive Helpline**, which can be reached at 1-800-566-6599 (Monday to Friday, 10am-6pm). Below are some further suggestions for making the most of this directory.

1 To find out how to **contact a specific agency or organization**, all you need to do is go to the alphabetized listings at the start of the directory (beginning on page 26). Depending upon the preference of the agency or organization, it may be listed either under the name of the institution as a whole (such as a hospital) or under a specific program name (such as a particular clinic or department). So please be sure to check under any possible program names.

2 To **find a particular type of service**, you should go to the index that begins on page 7. We have listed more than twenty types of services. Examples of types of services would be Harm Reduction, Housing, Mental Health, and Women's Services. For practical reasons, we could not list every conceivable type of program and service, so we have used broad categories. You should choose the one, two, or even three headings that seem closest to the type of service you are seeking and then find the agencies in the alphabetical listings.

3 If you are **still seeking additional information**, you should call the BP Helpline or one of the other hotlines listed on page 7. You should always also feel free to ask for referrals from other knowledgeable people, such as a doctor, a counselor, a case manager, or someone else in a professional capacity.

4 To find additional **services outside of the New York City area**, your best bet would be to search via the Internet. One outstanding source of HIV/AIDS information is the website The Body (www.thebody.com). When you reach the homepage of The Body, click on "Contacts" and then "Get Help." You can also find a wealth of information just by using Internet search engines, such as www.yahoo.com or www.google.com. Just enter the appropriate category of service (such as prevention, treatment, or mental health), but be sure to add the term HIV/AIDS and the location you wish to search (for example, the city and state). Remember than in any Internet search, the more specific you can be in the terms you search, the more targeted and relevant your search results will be.

HEALTHY LIFE CHOICES PROJECT

HIV-positive individuals experiencing chronic diarrhea (soft or loose stools three times per day for three weeks or more) are invited to participate in the Healthy Life Choices Project, a controlled clinical trial to determine whether strategies related to diet and behavior can help reduce the frequency of diarrhea in people with HIV. The study, which is noninvasive, investigates a combined dietary and behavioral intervention using normal foods to improve the symptom of diarrhea. No medication is given as part of the study, and participants may remain on their current medications, including antidiarrheal medications. STUDY FOR HIV-NEG. GAY/BI MEN

Previous research tells us that people who are depressed have a hard time making the changes they want to make in their lives. It also suggests that there is probably a connection between depression and risky sex in gay and bisexual men. Project CHANGE wants to know if treating depressed HIV-negative gay and bisexual men with an anti-depressant – one that doesn't have sexual side effects – can help them stay safer. If you think– or know– that you're depressed but are not currently in therapy or taking medications to treat it, you might be eligible. NEW RESEARCH STUDY FOR FATIGUE

HIV-positive men and women with severe and persistent fatigue may be eligible for a new research study of Provigil (Modafinil). Provigil is an approved and marketed medication to improve wakefulness in patients with excessive daytime sleepiness associated with narcolepsy. It is now being studied for fatigue. The study is intended to determine if Provigil can effectively treat fatigue that is persistent and severe enough to interfere with the person's daily activities and does not have an untreated underlying cause such as depression, hypogonadism, anemia, or hypothyroidism. Individuals considered for the study will be on antiretroviral medications. During the four-week study, all participants meet with the study psychiatrist weekly or biweekly (during the day) at New York State Psychiatric Institute/Columbia University Medical Center. All patients will get Provigil, but for some there may be a four week delay. Responders may continue to receive Provigil for another two months; non-responders are offered other medical options.
