GLOBAL ESTIMATES FOR ADULTS AND CHILDREN, 2005

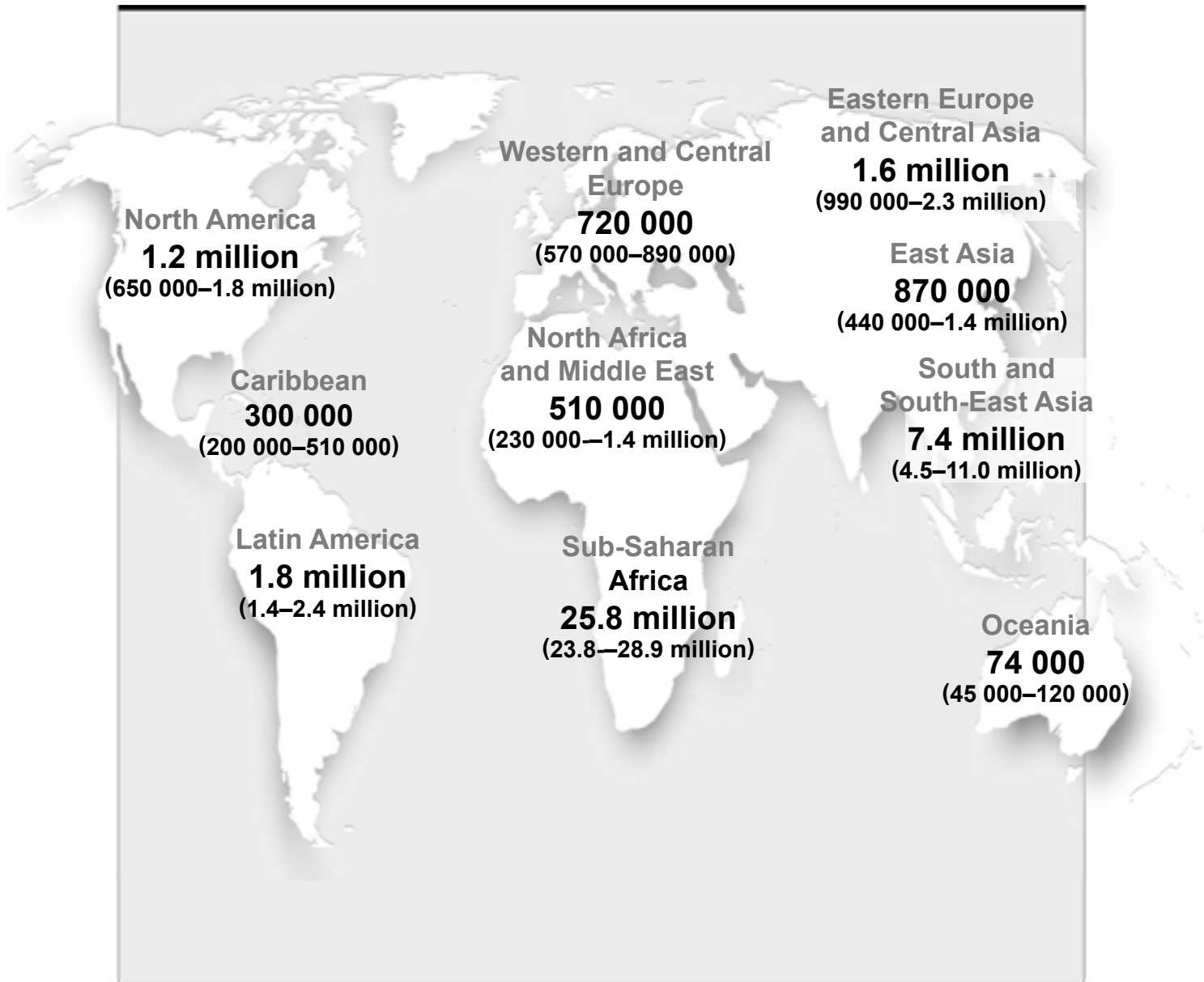


People living with HIV	40.3 million (36.7–45.3 million)

Total: 40.3 (36.7–45.3) million



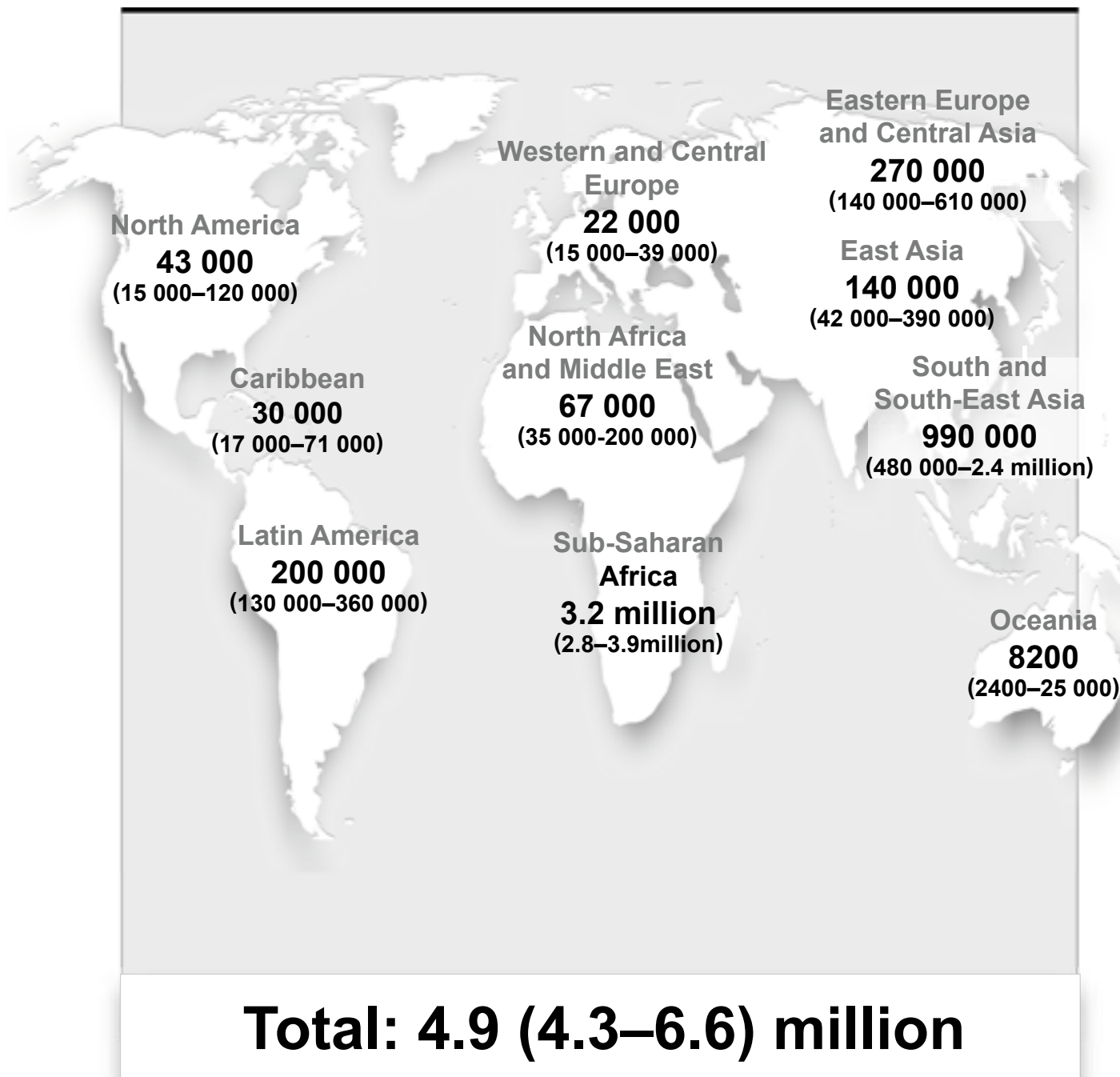

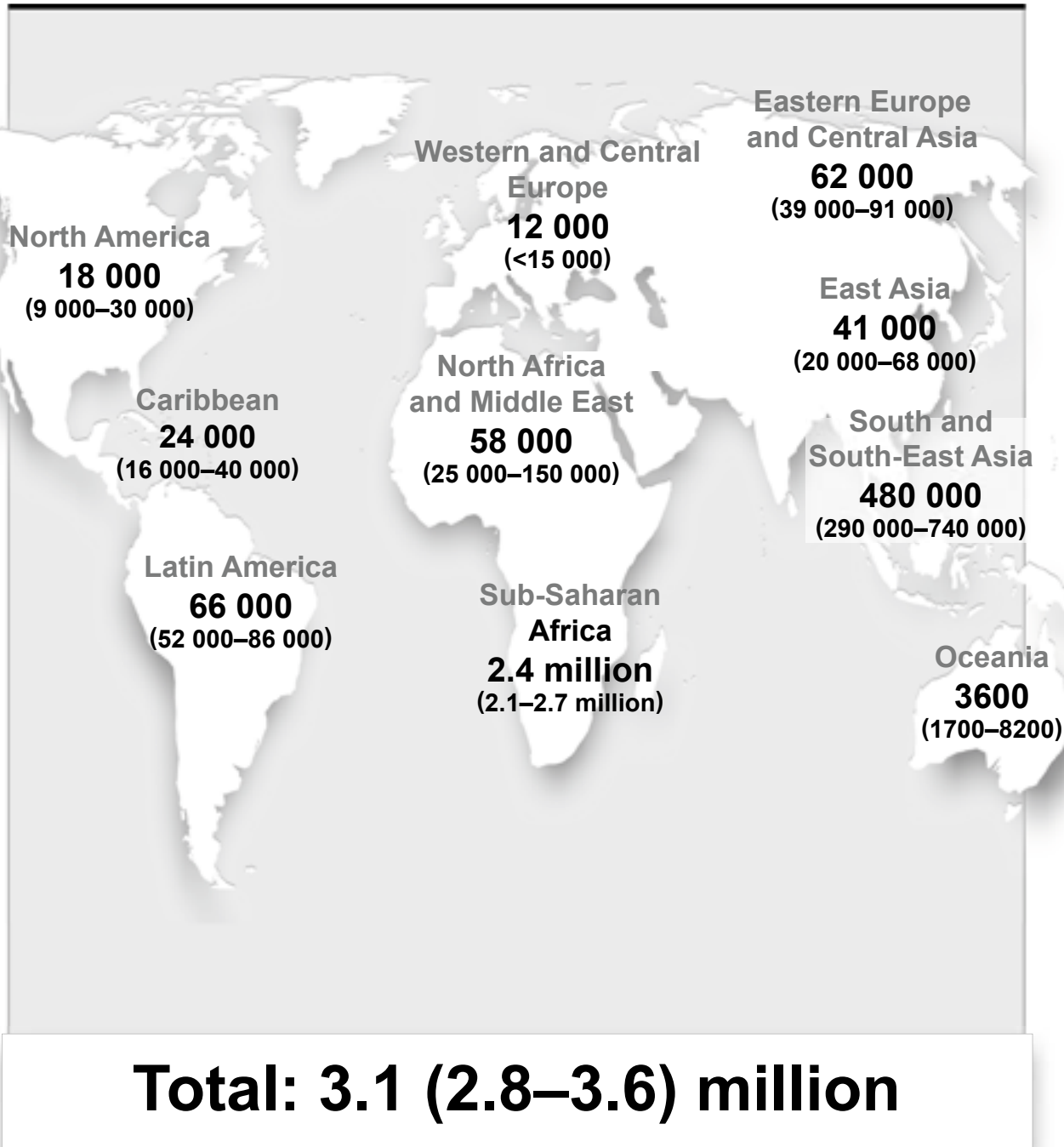
