Predominantly Sensory Neuropathy (PSN) of AIDS	
IMMUNE-MEDIATED:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Inflammatory demyelinating polyneuropathies (IDPs) • Acute (Guillain-Barré syndrome) • Chronic (CIDP)
INFECTIOUS:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cytomegalovirus polyradiculopathy • Cytomegalovirus multiple mononeuropathy • Herpes zoster • Mycobacterial (MAI)
TOXIC/NUTRITIONAL:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Alcohol, Vitamin deficiencies (B 6, B12) • Antiretrovirals: ddI (didanosine), ddC (zalcitabine), d4T (stavudine) • Anti-virals: foscarnet • PCP prophylaxis: dapsone • Anti-bacterial: metronidazole • Anti-mycobacterials: INH (isoniazid), rifampin, ethionamide • Anti-neoplastics: vincristine, vinblastine
OTHER MEDICAL CONDITIONS:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Diabetic neuropathy • Post-herpetic neuralgia
